Meeting Minutes

May 20th, 2019

The regular scheduled meeting of the Lincoln Pipestone Rural Water (LPRW) System Board of Commissioners was held at the LPRW office in Lake Benton on Monday, May 20th, 2019, starting at 6:00 pm. Chairman Earl DeWilde called the meeting to order with Commissioners Glen Grant, Bill Ufkin, Joe Weber, Rod Spronk, Mitch Kling, Randy Kraus, Brent Feikema, Jan Moen and Frank Engels present. Commissioner Jerry Lonneman was absent. Also present was Board Attorney Ron Schramel, DGR Engineers Darin Schriever and Logan Smidt, Kinner and Co. Nathan Kinner, Enterprise Technician Jodi Greer, Field Supervisor Tom Muller, General Manager Jason Overby.

Agenda: M/S Ufkin/Kraus to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

<u>Minutes:</u> M/S Engels/Feikema approve minutes from the April 2019 Board Meeting. Motion carried.

<u>Hydrogeology Services Presentation:</u> Dave Hume with Leonard Rice Engineers, Inc. gave presentation of his new firm, LRE, and the services they provide. Hume then presented the final report from WSP for the North Area (Dawson-Boyd) Water Source 7-day pump test. Board questioned the overrun on budget. Hume explained that due to unforeseen circumstances in weather, additional test wells that were drilled, and the additional requirements imposed by the DNR instigated the increase in project costs. Hume then identified the next steps in the water development project.
